

Name of Event: **State Level Workshop on Sustainable Livelihood in Jharkhand**

Date: **11th & 12th June, 2024**

Venue: **Ranchi**

On June 11th and 12th, 2024, a two-day state-level workshop on Sustainable Livelihoods was organized at Ranchi, attended by over 35 stakeholders. The workshop aimed to assess stakeholders' efforts in promoting sustainable livelihoods over the past three years and strategize for future challenges through collaborative approaches. It focused on enhancing stakeholder capacity to meet the needs of vulnerable and tribal groups, emphasizing evidence-based learning and the development of best practices. The ultimate goal was to create an enabling environment to influence government policies and ensure effective implementation of existing schemes on the ground.



Participants were grouped at the workshop to reflect on key achievements, challenges, and their underlying factors from 2020 to 2024. Discussions highlighted the critical need to strengthen collaboration with the government and develop effective solutions. The workshop emphasized that enhancing capacity is essential for fostering dialogue with diverse stakeholders, including government entities, and driving meaningful change. Finally, a road map for next two years was also developed and shared among the participants.
